

## **Pre-Surgical Instructions for National Spay Alliance Foundation**

Your pet has been scheduled for sterilization surgery. **The night before the procedure:** Please do not allow access to any food or treats after 10pm the night before anesthesia **\*\*However, if pet is under 5#: Please do not restrict food intake. Please do not restrict access to water.**

**The morning of the procedure:** Drop-off for dogs is 7:30-8:00am  
Drop-off for cats is 8:00-8:30am

Please allow adequate time when dropping off to complete paperwork and speak with our staff.

If you need to cancel this appointment, please reply to this email indicating so. When clients "no show" (meaning do not cancel and do not show up) it takes away a spot from another animal that might have had surgery that day. It's very important to let us know if you need to cancel, if **we do not receive a 24hr notice you will lose your deposit.**

Please arrive between **7:30 - 8:00 AM with your DOG.**

between **8:00 - 8:30 AM with your CAT.**

**These times are important please ensure you arrive during the time slotted for you pet. If you arrive late there will be a \$20 late fee. If you arrive 30 minutes or more late we will not be able to intake your animal for surgery.**

**Carriers/Leashes:** Dogs must be brought in on a leash. Please come in and complete paperwork prior to bringing the pet in. Cats **MUST** be in a proper carrier. For the safety of your animal and our staff, please bring each cat in a separate carrier, cardboard carriers are not acceptable. **THEY MUST BE HOUSED IN SEPARATE CARRIES, WE WILL NOT SEND THEM HOME IN THE SAME CARRIER AND WE DO NOT HAVE CARRIERS TO LOAN.** Cats will not be accepted if brought in towels, pillowcases, boxes, laundry baskets etc.
