Pre-Surgical Instructions

The night before the procedure:

- Please do not allow access to any food or treats after 10pm the night before anesthesia
- **However, if pet is under 5#: Please do not restrict food intake
- Please do not restrict access to water

The morning of the procedure:

Drop-off for pet is between 7:30-8:30am

Please allow adequate time when dropping off to complete paperwork and speak with our staff

Carriers/Leashes:

Dogs must be brought in on a leash. Please come in and complete paperwork prior to bringing in pet

Cats MUST be in a proper carrier. For the safety of your cat and our staff, please bring each cat in a separate carrier. We will not release multiple cats in 1 carrier. We do not have carriers to lend. Cats will not be accepted if brought in towels, pillowcases, cardboard carries or boxes etc.

Vaccination History:

Pets must be current on Rabies vaccines.

Showing Proof of Vaccination:

Only **written records from a veterinarian** showing dates administered will be accepted as proof.

**Vaccine pamphlets showing owner/breeder administered vaccines will need to be verified by documentation from the administering veterinarian. We do not need our own copy, simply bring proof on morning of surgery for verification.

If Rabies Vaccine is NOT current:

We will administer the necessary vaccine for an additional fee of \$15 on the day of surgery.

Optional vaccines are also available if requested.

Proof of prior Rabies vaccination is required for 3 year vaccine

Additional surgery fees apply if your animal:

- weighs more than 50#
- is in heat
- is pregnant
- has an un-descended testicle

Pets may be picked-up between 4:30-5:00pm Payment is due upon pick up.

We accept cash, Visa, MasterCard (There is a 4% Credit Card Fee)
